#### What was Jehoshaphat king of Judah known for:

**Jehoshaphat** is remembered for his efforts to remove idolatry and promote the worship of the one true God. He commissioned priests and Levites to teach the people the law of God.

He also appointed judges throughout the cities of Judah to ensure justice and righteousness. He fortified his kingdom against the Kingdom of Israel, building strongholds and fortresses.

He also established a strong military, which helped him maintain peace and prosperity.

When faced with a military alliance of Moabites and Ammonites, Jehoshaphat proclaimed a nationwide fast and gathered his people at the temple to seek God's guidance.

He famously prayed for God's intervention and trusted in God's promise of victory, even when facing a seemingly insurmountable enemy.

(23) Then the Ammonites and Moabites attacked the people from Mount Seir and annihilated them. After they had finished off the people of Seir, they helped destroy one another.

**This self-destruction among the enemies of Israel** is where God causes confusion among opposing forces) It serves as a testament to God's power to save His people without them having to engage in battle. # RUACH SPIRIT

On the surf coast of Victoria, Australia, amazing, bent-over trees dot the landscape. The trees bend over at a more than 90-degree angle, so that the top leaves are touching the ground. These trees are not deformed. Rather, they have been shaped this way. Despite a strong trunk, deep roots, and thick branches, these trees have been bent by the strong prevailing winds that blow through the region. They were transformed from the time they started to shoot leaves. These trees are strong and healthy, but they have been influenced by the power of the wind.

I think these trees are an awesome picture of the way the Spirit of God transforms us. The Hebrew word for *wind* is *ruach*, which also means “Spirit” or “breath” of God. When we choose to let the *ruach* of God transform and influence us, we will look different—just like the bent-over trees in Australia—to the people around us. We will stand out.

You are influenced and transformed by something, either the people you spend time with, the choices you make, or the *ruach* of God. Your life doesn’t get transformed by chance; it is transformed by choice.
