(The Church Is Heading To THE Promised Land)

2 Timothy 1:7

(Fear Is Not Of God)

Amplified Bible

(7) For God did not give us a spirit of timidity or cowardice or fear, but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment and personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].

God does not use anxious fear or terror to guide Christians; instead, He leads through peace, love, and the assurance of His grace. Anxious Fear: Panic, worry, and dread are not tools God uses to direct your daily choices. The Bible repeatedly tells believers "do not be afraid" when they face major decisions or changes.

(Hell Is Not A Fear Tactic, It's A Warning)

Ephesians 3:6

(Jews and Gentiles who believe in Jesus Christ)

Amplified Bible

(6) [it is this:] that the Gentiles are now joint heirs [with the Jews] and members of the same body, and joint partakers [sharing] in the [same divine] promise in Christ Jesus through [their faith in] the good news [of salvation].

Being a "joint heir" (or "co-heir") with Christ means that believers in Jesus share equally in the spiritual rights, privileges, and eternal inheritance belonging to God's Son.

the Gentiles are fellow heirs: Gentile believers receive the same inheritance promised to God's redeemed people: forgiveness, adoption, The Holy Spirit, resurrection life, and an eternal place in God's kingdom. No ethnic distinction remains as a basis for access to God's saving grace. The promise to Abraham that all families of the earth would be blessed reaches its fulfillment in **Christ Jesus**. Romans 8:17, Galatians 3:29

fellow members of the body: Jews and Gentiles who believe in Jesus Christ belong to one Church, the body of Christ. Christ has removed the hostility created by sin and has made peace through His blood. The early church's shared worship, fellowship, and service displayed a unity that crossed longstanding religious, social, and cultural divisions. 1st Corinthians 12: 12-13, 1st Corinthians 12:27, Romans 12:4-5

and fellow partakers of the promise: Gentile believers share fully in the blessings of the new covenant, including the gift and indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit. Eternal life belongs equally to all who trust in Christ, because salvation rests upon **His** faithfulness and sacrifice rather than ancestry, law-keeping, or human achievement. Union with **Christ** is the source of this shared inheritance, unity, and promise. **Jesus is the promised Messiah of Israel and the Savior of the world**, bringing into one redeemed people all who come to God through faith in **Him**. (17) And if [we are His] children, [then we are His] heirs also: heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ [sharing His spiritual blessing and inheritance], if indeed we share in His suffering so that we may also share in His glory.

And if we are children, then we are heirs: God's children belong fully to His household and receive the inheritance promised to His people. Roman adoption granted an adopted child the legal standing and inheritance rights of a natural-born child, illustrating the security of believers' adoption through Christ. As Abraham's spiritual offspring by faith, they inherit the covenant blessings fulfilled in Christ. Faithful identification with Christ brings opposition in a world that rejected Him. Such suffering includes persecution, loss, trials, and the daily cost of obedience. Let's Look At The Story/Parable Of The Ten Virgins Other Than The Way Many Of Us Were Taught. This past Thursday in Bible study, Pastor Sandy briefly mentioned the story of the ten virgins (Matt 25:1-13) and I immediately heard in my Spirit and understood the following,

The Ten Virgins

(what I heard) The Church is now ready to enter In (the gentiles); the other bride (the Jewish nation) is not. Christ and His Church will come back to rescue The other Bride (Israel).

(My Understanding) 5 Virgins had oil and 5 did not. 5 Virgins went in, 5 did not BUT! Later they did receive oil and when they went back, HE had gone, this is why Christ and His Church/Bride have to come back.

When the Bible speaks of oil in lamps most famously in the Parable of the Ten Virgins in Matthew 25, it serves as a symbol of The Holy Spirit and true spiritual readiness. Just as a physical clay lamp needs oil to produce light and function in the dark, a person's life needs the inner presence and power of God to shine spiritually in this dark and evil place.

Genuine Faith and Life: The Oil also stands for a real, living, day to day relationship with Jesus Christ rather than an outward show of religion.

Preparedness: In Matthew 25, the wise Virgins brought extra oil, while the foolish Virgins ran out. This highlights that personal readiness for Christ's return cannot be borrowed or faked at the last minute; it requires a deeply personal and sustained walk with Christ Jesus as LORD.

Two separate Brides (5 & 5) (In Hebrew the number 10 symbolizes completeness, divine order, totality) both expecting to get Marriage. One was in Right Standing and one Thought they were in Right Standing. The Church will be taken but the nation of Israel left because they don't have The Oil of Christ YET, not in Right standing YET

Heh (ה), is the fifth letter of the Hebrew alphabet (5)

The prophetic number 5 can also represent God's grace, unearned favor, and goodness toward mankind. God sharing His Grace with His Brides (The Jews & The Gentiles) creating a nationality of "Believers"

Behold: As a standalone word or exclamation, it means "behold," "look," or "see" Telling His Brides Look-Behold

Breath and Spirit: Ancient pictographs pictured the letter as a person with raised arms or a breath/sigh, symbolizing revelation, the Holy Spirit, or the breath of life. *God Says Behold I'm Sharing My Grace, My Favor, The Breath Of Life and, The Holy Spirit with My Brides. Both Will Be Rescued; Both Will Live In My Kingdom With Me.*
